A 14 Point Memorandum of Surrender

The Trump/Iran, 14 point, *Memorandum of Understanding* adds-up to total surrender on the part of the US. Because of that, no one in the public arena knows which of the 14 points, if any, have been agreed to. For Trump, this is one last gasp of kick the can.

It was supposed to be signed in Switzerland—instead it was signed early. Why early? Because Trump finally understands that the world, because of his actions, has reached the precipice of economic collapse, sooner than what was already coming. Was Trump going to Switzerland? Of course not—things are bad enough without photo-opts of Trump shaking hands with the Iranian president. Would he have sent Sec/State Rubio (whose constitutional duty it is)? No—he opted for Vance.
