My friend, Bill Holter, is thinking there will be no midterms. That something will happen to cause the elections to be called-off. If he is correct, that would necessitate an event of staggering dimension—something like a nuclear detonation that could be blamed on the Russians (although most nations would recognize a US 'October Surprise'). If a nuclear 'surprise' were to happen, the circumstances surrounding it would be vital because, if Russia judged it to be an existential threat to Russia, they would go-out as martyrs, after unleashing their nuclear arsenal on the West, rendering humanity extinct.

Assuming there is to be no nuclear detonation, something that results in 'martial law' would have to be imposed in the US. This would be America's ultimate political threat, putting the Constitution along with the republic on the 'chopping block of extinction'.

The US Constitution makes no provision for the federal government to call-off elections. Elections are the purview of states and not subject to federal intervention. If 'martial law' were declared, it would be an unconstitutional act—as is the case with republican lawmakers impeded from accessing data on 'voting rights' changes, state to state—hampered to assure that the reins of power remain in the hands of the 'left'.

Consider the trials of Alex Jones. Whatever you think of Jones, he is denied free speech rights during his trials—where there is little difference between Jones and Julian Assange, manacled in a glass box. Back home in the States, the FBI and the DOJ have become 'rogue entities', but rogues that are aligned with neoliberals. This is a common phenomena in the breakdown of an empire where no one is really in charge, and what you get is 'diversity politics' played out on a national and global scale—with everybody in it for themselves.

Yet the empire, as with its means of settlement, the dollar, persists—if just for now. Democratic lawmakers in Congress openly champion empire through their unexamined support for Ukraine while 14th Amendment guarantees are disallowed for conservative legislators who question the 2020 election. Free speech has become a bad joke.
