A common theme in today's conversations is 'shock' at how easily those around us were herded like sheep into 'vaccinations', masks, and lockdowns. Considering human nature, there is little reason for any 'shock'. In Aleksandr Solzhenitsyn's "Gulag Archipelago", few, of millions of Russians charged, failed to sign a total confession. Only to find that after signing, the interrogation began again, because this was a real-life "1984" where it's not enough to give yourself up. To avoid torture/unsurvivable sentences/likely death, to cling to hope of release, you must give-up those closest to you.

Reading history tells of the horrors elites have planned as our future, and history tells why we can't allow them to win. What they have in mind is a 'fascist tyranny', all decked out as 'communism'. Neither concept—average Americans know much about.

10s of millions (more), of our fellows were slaughtered in the name of National Socialism (Hitler), and communism—advanced by Lenin/Stalin. What's the difference?

National Socialist Germany was not the result of an ideology, but the consequence of 'reparations' demanded after Germany's defeat in WW1. Germans were angry; they wanted revenge and retribution. As a result, Germany and the world got Adolph Hitler.

Basically, that's what happened, and we all know how that played out for mankind. Russia is its own distinct case. Bolshevism (communism), came to power following Germany's defeat in 1918, with the assassination of Tzar Nicholas and his family.

Communism is an ideology, ironically a system developed by Marx and Engles, both Germans. The Bolshevik ideology took hold under Vladimir Lenin. When Lenin died in 1924, Joe Stalin came to power, bringing with him a 30 year reign of terror—until 1953.

What's the purpose of this little history? First of all, to remind any who do not know, that National Socialism and Communism have been responsible for mass slaughter of human beings, unparalleled in world history. And, remind us we are headed back there.

Making it worse, the US is becoming a 'national socialism' wherein government, aligned with 'monied interests', is resulting in the complete subjugation of the populace. Across the West, 'fascism' is promoted as 'communism' to a population not understanding the consequences of either. And it's being sold under the guise of equity, inclusivity, multiculturalism—concepts that in theory align themselves with communism.

Elite goals, opposed to concepts of equity, is evidenced by self-serving politicians, without concern for the welfare of Americans, adding wealth to already 'deep pockets'.

In a scenario devoid of consideration for the 'rule of law', left-leaning states openly defy the Constitution and Bill of Rights, as well as Supreme Court findings. Along this road to anarchy, the US no longer recognizes 'separation of powers' or views the Constitution as the 'law of the land'. In its place, 'equity/inclusivity/multiculturalism' have been rolled-out so as to make everything a 'matter of opinion'. That the Supreme Court recognizes keeping/bearing arms, doesn't mean states agree. Disregarding the Supreme Court as the final constitutional arbiter—states go ahead with gun restriction.

'Contextualism' defines everything 'in context' (matters of opinion). Ever-changing, circumstances requires 'living document laws'—subject to modification as needed. Now pervasive, laws are enforced or unenforced, not by law—instead for political purpose.

The US is on the road to anarchy, that ends with removal of 'rule of law' and 'due process'. That was the case in Stalinist Russia. What began as 'fair wages', and equity for 'collective farms' soon became mass arrest, interrogation, torture, and death. With no right to a lawyer, and no right/ability to read the law—you simply sign a confession. Once the tyrant achieves total control, the paranoia extends to anybody—everybody.

Consider how it works. The democracy comes apart—always because of debt. In the 'decline and fall' of Rome, it got so bad that hoodlum gangs were tasked with collecting taxes (extracting wealth from anyone they could). Here—IRS agents are now armed.

Democracy, without the 'rule of law/due process' descends into anarchy. Soon, an 'entitled body politic' suddenly finds that what they thought they owned, they do not, what they thought were their savings, are not. The job they relied on—no longer exists.

A former, dependable social fabric that relied on the Constitution/Bill of Rights and a 'New Testament' motif of 'brotherly love' no longer finds wide acceptance. With all human behavior reduced to a 'matter of opinion' there is nothing reliable to stop a 'tsunami of chaos' that will be the consequence of an economic collapse. So, what comes?

The only thing to quell an economic collapse is general acceptance to 'tighten belts' and shift course from 'spending to saving', to trade living 'on the spread' for hard work.

I don't see that happening. Instead, in the 'dregs of anarchy', here comes the tyrant to save the democracy (to save the people). The tyrant (who like Nixon closing the 'gold window' *temporarily* in 1971), promises that 'martial law' is necessary, only 'temporarily', to quell right wing extremism/'white privilege'—to protect the 'underprivileged'.

So many (like Russians confessing to crimes they never committed)—go along, trusting that unspeakable terror that comes with arrest in the night by 'Black Maria', could not happen to them. So, they stay with the herd—to feel included. For others, there's the intoxication of the petty tyrant. Finally, they will have to be paid attention to.

I'm betting the tyrant scenario does not play-out (hopefully), but, given mRNA, illegal migrant criminality, and a debt on which the interest cannot be paid, we shall see. After 750 miles of "Gulag Archipelago" (a 12 hour audiobook), I know it can get much worse.

What I've gleaned: in total tyranny where day to day actions are left to 'petty tyrant discretion', there is little value in trying to pacify the perpetrators. It's better to let them know, from the onset, they are the criminals, and the tyrant they have deified on the wall is just another sick psychopath. That said, 'let the chips fall where they belong'.

Whoever said this would be easy? As a young man I turned down a philosophy Phd at Edinburgh. I wouldn't have survived in a coat and tie world. We, who, from the onset, were both outsiders and unable to not speak up, in the end, are likely—better off.
