Today I'm in Northern Iowa, driving backroads, meeting with subscribers. This is day 8 of meeting-up with rational Americans—and it's life-affirming. Trump is hated by the Left—maybe more than the devil incarnate. Some of his bad press is self-generated. He's a huge narcissist, not all that bright—and a bad judge of character, if you consider Pompeo, Bolton, Barr, Pence, his daughter and son-in-law, and a host of others. Because of that he is a good candidate for 'deer in the headlights' status, but it's the FBI that is the 'headlights' of an out-of-control, insane 18 wheeler.

Trump got caught-up in Mar-a-Lago because the Supreme Court, over decades, watered-down American citizen's rights of privacy under the 4th Amendment. The resultant 'sweeping' search warrant for the President's home gives off an odor of 3rd world politics. 'Sweeping searches', granted by the Crown, were a major Colonial objection to British Rule—one of the principle causes for the Declaration of Independence.

The 'purpose' of the Constitution is to limit the power of government in favor of the citizens, who are 'the sovereigns'. The President of the United States is the chief law enforcement officer (Article 1, Section 3). As such he directs and uses resources such as 'law enforcement' to carry-out his duty to enforce the laws of the United States.

However, with unimpeded growth of government, especially since the closing of the gold window in 1971, 'agencies' and 'law enforcement' (deep state), now see themselves as a 4th branch of government, a government in which they 'reign supreme', and in which they see the President in the same way the Queen functions in Britain subservient to them and expected to sign-off (as a figurehead) to government policy.

Making things worse, this '4th branch' of government operates in secret—as with Mar-a-Lago, for which their objective is a 2 part strategy—to get Trump. The case against Trump functions: to seek an indictment in the courts for 'obstruction of justice' (based on an unconstitutional search), and, more importantly, go after Trump in the 'court of public opinion', with intention to prevail in the midterms and 2024 election.

What is obvious is the FBI lines-up with the Left—allegedly having suppressed the Hunter Biden laptop story and allegedly sharing responsibility for the search of Trump's

home. A corrupt police force undermines a nation and is made exponentially worse by a 'partisan', corrupt police force—resulting in law-enforcement rotting from the inside.

Because 'grand juries' are shills for the prosecution, Trump could be indicted for 'obstruction of justice' if the FBI can present 'classified' documents which he did not acknowledge having. Though pilloried in the press, he would likely be found not-guilty. But the '4th estate' doesn't care because what they want is for Trump to look bad—and they assume this will help win the mid-terms and stop Trump from running in 2024. To this end they maintain it is a crime to hold classified material, even if it ceased to need protection 50 years ago, or has been declassified by the President (as in this case).

Trump is not prosecutable unless the Left can somehow tie 'obstruction of justice' to something like the *Espionage Act* because the 'Presidential Records Act' (preservation of Presidential records), does not involve penalties. He may be obliged to turn papers over, but he's already seen them, and there is no crime. What the Left rest their case on is a bullshit claim that he obstructed justice by failing to identify held materials.

Unfortunately, president after president allowed a megalomaniac, J. Edgar Hoover, to build an unconstitutional 'law enforcement agency' that morphed into its present usage. If the FBI has a function, it serves the president to stop crime. Is the Biden administration using the FBI to undermine a former president? Unlike Obama who secretly undermined Trump, Mar-a-Lago is as 'in your face' as the January 6th prosecutions.

There may be a good end to all this. Democrats control college professors who control polling and wide-eyed pollsters, but they are the absolute worst at falling for their own hype—often missing American sentiment by more than 10%. The networks are now treating us to projections that Dems are closing the gap, probably holding on the the Senate and maybe the House, when, in fact, they will be annihilated in November.

But as long as 'leftist morons' believe they can win, there is less chance of a nuclear war by the '2nd Tuesday', or a staged economic collapse—'October surprise'.
