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It's Going To Get Much Worse—And More Dangerous

Alex Krainer (who I greatly admire), is of the opinion Trump is playing a game, intended to disassociate from the old empires of Britain and France that are hellbent on destabilizing the Middle East. Instead, Trump wants to dump them/Israel—trade with BRICS.

I pray that Alex is correct, and were that happen, I would be the 1st to admit it, but over the past 2 months, I've watched Trump be taken over by the neocons, to where he is acting-out a role he does so well—that of a calculating, 18th century colonizer.

Trump's war is against the BRICS—something he does not understand. Trump does know what the BRICS are—he calls it 6 nations *from* BRICS that are trying to dethrone the US dollar—when it's most of the world trying to get free from a weaponized dollar.

Meanwhile, the British/Ukraine want to take out Putin, to be replaced by someone more aggressive, such as Medvedev, who will attack NATO. To disassociate, Tulsi runs inference for Trump, focusing on RussiaGate, taking focus from Iran/Israel/Russia.

What do I see coming? Likely a couple of Gettysburgs against BRICS, with the US as the South, a 1929-style collapse. Maybe a civil war—first. Unlike Joshua and the Israelites, where at Jericho the walls miraculously came tumbling down, the wall of the West will be obscured in clouds of smoke from atomized mortar, and the terrifying din of lost battles. When will all this occur? Between now and much sooner than you think.

In the lead-up, Americans, acclimatized by Bitcoin/bull markets, are day-trading off the charts—in search of improbable returns. Instead, a vital lesson awaits them: bull markets do not go quietly into the good night—they die in sheiks—in fear and in tears.

All that will matter as we transition from worse to dangerous will be those things that make survival possible—real things capable of sustaining life/making trade possible.

Danger signs are everywhere across the US. There's a critical shortage of energy generation capacity, nationally, and a rising cost of energy. In my Oregon town, even when there's no problems from forest fires, we have rolling blackouts from shared US grids—as old as a Fort Knox gold audit. The US is transitioning into 3rd world status.

The average car loan is 1000 bucks (35% loans denied). Unemployed young put groceries on the card. As in the *Great Depression*, when 25% lost jobs, for a time, the 75% were not directly affected. This time will be much worse, with everybody effected.

What's the global reality? The West are the bad guys and BRICS are the good guys. After 40 years of sanctions, Iran managed to develop itself to where it was winning the

12 Day War with Israeli. And Yemen, the whole region around Yemen is against them, technology, airspace, radar. The Houthis, starved, sanctioned, bombed by US/Saudi Arabia/Israel, for a decade, manage to wreak havoc on Israel. And now, here come a reluctant Russia/China to the rescue. Is this a promise the Global South will stand?

There's talk about Iran now going for nukes. No, even remembering when the US funded sanctions that would not let Iran import gas masks to fend-off Iraqi gas, Iran neither wants nor needs nukes. They know nukes aren't solely deterrence—they're destabilization. What is needed, instead, is for the State of Israel to be kicked-out of the United Nations, censured by the world, and stripped of its arsenal of illegal nukes.

View in the West—everybody's going to make so much money. Trump, and the EU are playing a game of *chicken* with Russia. These new weapons, capable of striking deep into Russia, produced by the US, and given to Ukraine by EU nations are entirely traceable. As such—subject to Russia's *nuclear retaliation* doctrine. West best look out.

As for the US dollar, central banks haven't increased treasury holdings in 11 years. The next time you hear Trump degrading Powell over interest rates, remember that it was Trump who appointed Powell—and lower interest rates could make things worse.

Trump is living in a past century, making friends and foes pay tribute for a role the US used to have. The US is no longer that economic powerhouse, and god forbid the world gets to see the US at war with Russia/China—wars the US couldn't possibly win.

As for WW3, if EU gets to 5% GDP to arm/perpetuate war in Ukraine—that will be the end of Europe. And, using Russia's FOREX to pay for long range missiles going to Ukraine? What a great idea to support a fair/balanced West image across the globe.

Is war with Iran over? Likely not. Look at what Trump created for himself: he was going to crush Yemen. A glorious victory—but only on FOX News. Will Russia make the same mistake it made in Syria? Syria went down for 2 reasons: Assad would not heed the warning of Russia/China, and because of war in Ukraine, Russia allowed al Jolani to be installed as president (like Zelensky in Ukraine), without a necessity for elections.

Fortunately, Iran was a wake-up call. Israeli treachery worked—but like the devastation the Luftwaffe inflicted on Coventry in WW2 that appeared absolute—not for long. Iran regrouped, re-established its air defense and began missile attacks on Israel—even if at first they appeared ineffective. Today, who won the 12 day war is debatable.

Trump didn't end the Ukraine war on day 1, and it needs remembered that the peace proposal in 2022 was put forward by Ukraine—not Russia. 60K Ukrainians were dead when US/Britain scuttled it—before another million young Ukrainians were slaughtered.

The global situation's changed drastically over a month to where there's little dispute as to the outcome in Ukraine. And Israel, to keep Bibi in power/out of jail, has witnessed its infrastructure/infallibility, attacked/destroyed on previously unthinkable scale.

Does Trump, in the fiction he inhabits, understand that no more than 15% of Americans support going to war with Iran? But, given his actions, it may not be a war he can avoid?
