Protests against Israel on US college campuses are being used as a political football. Some are quick to judge them as perpetrated by agitators, but are they? When we hear demonstrations are financed by those same persons who funded BLM/ANTIFA, consider that protests against Israeli mass murder, in an election year, hurt Biden/Bibi.

If the protests, like Vietnam, herald young persons having had enough of carnage/slaughter, at a time when there is no institutional anti-war faction in Congress, this could be the turning point when the people stand-up to the hegemony—the tyrannies.

Defending against a groundswell of young Americans (Westerners), protesting the elite, the US, Ukraine, and Israeli governments have decided to become 'terrorist organizations', deflecting criticism for that mission by accusing their citizens of terrorism.
