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Trump is Driven by Low Self-Worth—Netanyahu is Worse

Because of hubris, the consequence of low self-worth, Hitler had an innate destructiveness that, over time, led to the demise of his regime and himself. This was seen in his listening to no one but himself and paying no heed to his generals when they advised for strategy retreats.

Trump shares that trait with Hitler and every other ego-maniac down through history. It is that hubris that brings such destruction to the world, but ends in a return to peace once the insane leader is vanquished. Unfortunately for the world—Trump is not alone.

Netanyahu, driven by necessity to avoid prison, does whatever is necessary to retain the Prime Minister-ship. Worse than Trump (maybe at the level of Pete Hegseth), Bibi holds no reverence for age-old rules of engage-
