*"We Have Met the Enemy—And He Is Us"*

Just grabbing some numbers out of the air, I've been ostracized by 82% of Americans. With the Hamas attack of October 7th, that number has abruptly risen to maybe, 91%.

The difference being that my Christian/Jewish friends, without intending to, argue for a 'final solution' to the Palestinian question, from 'biblical stories' rather than 'due process'. Did they forget our 'founders' were Christians, but that didn't stop them from inscribing 'due process'/human dignity into our lexicon, not Genesis 12.7, whatever?

I don't condone what Hamas did on October 7th. Unless compelled, I am anti-war—and any just war does not include the murder of innocents. But I understand what causes something such as Oct. 7th to happen—when a people have been denied, by force, from all aspects of 'pursuit of happiness'—to the point they disappear from view.

Gaza is described as an 'open-air prison'—something Jewish rationalizers profoundly disagree with—disingenuously? Because of 'Bibi's War', the description has been altered: now it's 2.3 million rats in a small cage, wherein half of them (falsely accused as hostiles), are herded to the other end of the cage by occupiers' who, by design or 'never letting a good crisis go to waste', act to eliminate a self-made problem—forever.

What most don't understand is that 'Bibi/Biden' are taking this opportunity (allegedly), to keep their sorry asses out of jail—the only sure way to do that is to stay in power—each deflecting facts through a war agenda—as a last gasp hope to hang onto power.

What about Gaza? More than half of the 2.3 million are juveniles, born and raised in slavery. Gaza has no port/airport—'born in a cage—die in a cage'. Meanwhile, James Howard Kunstler writes articles about how none of 22 Arab nations will accept Palestinian refugees. Is Mr. Kunstler conveying that more than a million kids were born bad?

This is like Ukraine, but worse. Recall when Russia invaded—and the history of Ukraine began on that day. There was no (alleged) US coup in 2014. There were no valid Russian security concerns. There was just that heartless thug—Putin—the killer.

Palestinian history began on October 7th. In years prior to 2023, Israelis could have maybe been more heartfelt to the people whose lands they 'ethnically cleansed', but you know—life is tough. If Israel was going to have a 'homeland' (everybody knows Jewish history is a history of persecution), it had to be somewhere where people already lived—as in Palestine where the inhabitants had lived on the land for centuries.

But the Jews had a plan that depended on a ratio: Israel was to be 80% Jews with

no more 20% Arabs—requiring 700,000 Arabs be evicted from what is now Israel. But, as with what took place in the 'American West'—that was not good enough. Under the Jews 'covenant with God' (Americans refer to 'manifest destiny'), there was never to be any 'land for peace' deals. 1st Americans were shunted about through broken agreements 'to make way for their betters'. In Palestine some 7000,000 Israeli settlers have moved into the 'exiled areas' displacing the already exiled—to far corners of the cage.

Over 20 months of war between Nazi battalions and Putin, 500 children have been killed. Over 3 weeks, the Bibi/Joe war has killed more than 2000 children. What can I say? Maybe the last line in a film spoken to Jack Nicholson? "Forget it..it's Chinatown."

The UN definition of 'genocide' requires intent—which is made easy by high Israeli government officials expressing 'intent': *complete erasure of Arab human animals* .

With the Oslo Accord, 1993, the UN abandoned its mandate in support of human rights, for a political role of negotiating among major actors. With this change, the UN quit talking about equal rights for Christians, Muslims, and Jews—shifting to a process for Israel and Palestine to work it out for themselves. Negotiations between the powerful and the powerless, between the occupier and occupied—the jailer and the caged.

When 2.3 million people are crushed into 5X25 mile area, where they continuously lose more land to Jewish settlers, they find themselves confined to a noncontiguous area from which they can't visit family. Instead they are born/die without the possibility of being able to leave, with energy/food/medicine (but no freedom), rationed by Israel.

How long has this been going on? Israeli sympathizers need a history lesson. It began in 1947, when Britain flip-flopped over Palestine—attempting to create a Jewish state in Palestine—fully aware the area was 90% Arabs and 10% Jews—had been for centuries. When agreement with inhabitants was unattainable, Zionism was deemed more important than whatever fate had in store for Arab (Palestinian) inhabitants.

There's a sad truth: There can be no '2 state solution' thanks to a 'spineless' UN that allowed what was left of Palestine to be sectioned-off by 100s of 1000s of illegal Jewish settlers. And there can be no '1 state solution' because, with an equal number of Arabs to Jews (7.5 million of each), that upsets Israeli 80/20 balance—Jews to Arabs

What has Israel done? Along with the US, they find themselves surrounded by 'hostiles'. Meanwhile, major human rights organizations describe what has been done to Palestinian as apartheid—the forcing of inhabitants (Palestinians), apart from others.

Because most of the world views Israel as 'heartless guards of an open-air prison', there can be no peace in the Jewish State. This is of Israel's making. In fact, if the Israeli plan for Gaza is followed through—there may be no Israel at all. Israel has plans to expel the population of Gaza to Egypt and pay to have them maintained in the Sinai.

For that, they rely on support from the US, a nation of military misadventure, recently driven from Afghanistan by Taliban. More than 'anger'—October 7 should raise 'fear'.

The war on Gaza is monstrous. Anyone seeing children as 'complicit hostiles' offers support for 'Rules-Based Order', which conveys a single intention—to undermine international law. Just another rationalizing of 'might makes right'—using techno-rhetoric.

If you are a Genesis 12.7 fan, I'm not interested in trading 'due process/Bill of Rights' for 'biblical stories'. I'll leave that to you. I'm a patriot. Go ahead and unsubscribe.
