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*“What Is He Whining About?”*

My title comes from Trump’s reply to a US Senator asking if his incursion into Venezuela is constitutional? Neither the question nor answer matter as both the US Constitution/UN Charter are on the chopping block—without any viable path to resolution.

A reader commented today: ‘I’m done...we’re done...stick a fork in it’. I don’t know for sure but I’m betting that like myself, he voted for peace president, Trump—twice.

Peace President Trump, over a year, has bombed 7 countries and is threatening 7 more. He’s done a few good things: dismantling climate change, hockey stick lies and getting illegals out of 18 wheelers, which pale next to him not accepting Putin’s offer to extend the New Start nuclear treaty, and his clearly unconstitutional Venezuelan fiasco.

It used to be that the world genuflected to Reagan who was regarded as a loose cannon, but it’s worse with Trump. Aware they are dealing with a madman, nuclear powers (Russia/China), proceed cautiously—through a blitz of US lies that everyone is equivocating to Trump. As in: the new president of Venezuela, Delcy Rodriguez, who soundly condemned Trump, has now reportedly walked backed her words. But has she?

Propagandized America is acquiescing to Trump’s actions as enhancing

our economy—as just another of 60-odd unconstitutional takedowns of world leaders by the CIA.

Venezuela is another feather in the cap of Allen Dulles, (tops my list of truly evil Americans), architect for the CIA, on whose shoulders lays the blame for 75 years of US Foreign Policy he shares with Genghis Khan, even Pol Pot—if we count corpses.
