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When Neurosis Becomes Psychosis

Not long ago it was assumed that each of us, to differing degrees, was neurotic. Maybe to hide an underlying psychological condition, we drank too much. We knew it was there, but were at a loss when it came to understanding and confronting our demon. We understood our neurosis needed to be dealt with and we would deal with it—all in good time.

Now, American culture has, or is, slipping a notch. We are buried in lies, especially those who tune into the networks. I ask you: how can a Pentagon spokesman or a Trump advisor present to an entire Sunday morning (non-news show), without uttering one fact?
