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Which Dictator Threatens Democracy?

I see *no* Trump lawn signs in my town, but there are signs where the top half is red, with the word, *dictator*—the bottom half is blue, with the word, *democracy*. And a slogan: *That's the choice*. Trump, the dictator—will end democracy. But, is that the case?

Remember the Covid lockdowns? Let me remind you why Dems don't want to think back on that event. Now, when only the brain-dead don't get that Fauci/Pharma should be tried for genocide, the left forgets that half of them favored fining 'unvaxxed', confining them to their homes, tracking them, imprisoning deniers, and 30%—take their kids.

Our founders, constructed a document (US Constitution), purposed to keep dictators at bay. Hence, US political candidates are measured by the Constitution/Bill of Rights.

Inaugurated, Trump needs to show support for the Bill of Rights and 14th Amendment (guarantees *equal protection* to all Americans)—by ending the twin destroyers, welfare and affirmative action. Bill Holter says he doesn't necessarily think there will be an election. Why might that be? With less than 2 weeks before the election (which in a sane world Trump wins), some major global players need to make a move—before they come under great risk.

Who are they? Netanyahu and all the little Biden's. The nuts-so of that group is Bibi—so what's his plan? As a last gasp, Bibi could strike Iran with tactical nukes. That's sure to get the attention of Lindsey Graham, Kamala, and President Jill—to bring the US in.

Obama used to speak of escalation dominance—and we might have had that during his 1st term—but we don't have it now. The US has a total of 7, THADD missile defense systems (that don't work against some of Iran's never missiles). Each THADD carries 48 missiles, to ward-off a missile attack by Iran, numbering in the 1000s.

What happens to Israel if the US does not enter a war they start? Or, if Israel uses tactical nukes after decades of US/Israel denials of their existence? That's further proof that the US knew, yet supplied weapons, illegal under UN Charter—to a nuclear state.

When Trump takes the mantle of power, it is the responsibility of Americans to *ride herd on him*, assuring he does not pick/choose among the Bill of Rights. Vote Trump.

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
