Consider human nature. Workers, in a time when government is in the grasp of 'the monied interests', come together (with good intention), to form a union so as to obtain an equitable share of profits. At first successful, then, from within and without, come the 'hoodlums', preying on the assets, as spoils, for their agenda of greed and power.

The 'Jimmy Hoffa' union saga, and the parallel rise of 'Cosa Nostra' ('our thing'/ Mafia), tells the story of a pernicious aspect of human nature making its way from a smallish island, Sicily, to become a major player in the economy of another continent.

Attacking 'free speech' he depicts social networks in terms of *algorithms* (interesting take on his name), that he then labels the 'digital equivalent' of AR-15s. More platforms to ban.

This confluence of Gore-isms is a serious development, but first, let's amuse ourselves with it. You might remember his wife Tipper, as the force behind banning explicit lyrics from groups such as 'Green Day', who's transgression was not wanting to be an American—given the degree of inhumanity the US was inflicting on the world.

Albert supported his wife's censorship that has now burgeoned into his platform for inflicting total control on the Western world (and rest of the world—if that be possible).

Lest we forget, Gore offered-up 'planks to his platform' at a global climate conference—one he no doubt attended in a private jet—using more CO2 than we imagine.

Consider the tactics that go into his strategy: he likened 'free speech' (at a time when the 2nd Amendment is under attack from all sides), as a 'AR-15'. And, he made his remarks in terms of 'climate change'—an imperative for the health of global citizenry.

The irony being: 'democracy' is hateful anathema for elites, 2nd worst to a 'body politic' wearing the garments of a 'republic'. In Gore's world, nobody gets the 'vote'. Except maybe for one last election where the herd is called-upon to vote away its rights.

Evil has now shifted into overdrive, without bounds. Elites no longer need explain except though pronouncements. John Kerry (climate czar), testifying in Congress was informed that CO2 levels were much higher before humans. He attributed that to geology. Is there bo geology now—no earthquakes/volcanoes? When questioned about his 2009 declaration when he assured that within 5 years the Arctic-melt would create an ice-free Arctic sea lane, he retorted to the questioner—'Not a serious conversation.'
